PROGRAM SYLLABUS

The Pharmacist Oncology education program will advance your knowledge in oncology and oncology drugs through a 10-week program. The program will focus on the ***Principles of Cancer Toxicity Management and Supportive Care***.



TOXICITY AND SUPPORTIVE CARE

COURSE DETAILS

WHEN?

- The course includes a total of 10 weekly sessions
- The first 5 sessions will run consecutively, every Wednesday, from October 13 - November 10, 2021
- The next 5 sessions will recommence January 12, 2022 and will end on February 9, 2022.
- The course will run from 7:00 - 8:30pm EDT.

WHAT?

BEFORE EACH SESSION:

- Independent completion of pre-read/pre-work material (approximately 45 min)

DURING EACH SESSION:

- Didactic presentation by Keynote Speaker
- Case presentations and discussion including 2-3 expert pharmacists.
- **TOTAL PROGRAM TIME: 1hr 15min -1hr 30min**
